MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- 2. Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolishment of any buildings or improvements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction within a reasonable time in accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto:
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;

To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as shall be satisfactory to the mortgagee; to deposit with the mortgagee all such policies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagee; the property of the mortgage of the property of the mortgagee; the property of the m

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgages shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgages shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.
