WITNESSETH

Vendor agrees to sell to the vendoe and the vendoe agrees to buy from the vendor all of the following described property situate in Kiamath County, State of Oregon, to-wit:

Cherico & Frances M. Cherico husband and wife, are Grantors, Transamerica Title Insurance Co. is Trustee, and Equitable Savings & Loan Association is Beneficiary, which Trust Deed shall be paid by the Vendor herein and the Vendor shall hold Vendee harmless thereon.

Vendee agrees to make said payments promptly on the dates above named to the order of the vendor, or the survivors of them, at the First Federal Savings and Loan Association

Oregon; to keep said property at all times in as good condition as the same now are, that no improvement now on or which may hereafter be placed on said property shall be removed or destroyed before the entire purchase price has been paid and that said property will be kept insured in companies approved by vendor against loss or damage by fire in a sum not less than \$\pi\$ full ins, value with loss payable to the parties as their respective interests may appear, said policy or policies of insurance to be held Vendor copy to Vendee that vendee shall pay regularly and seasonably and before the same shall become subject to interest charges, all taxes, assessments, liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind.

and agrees not to suffer or permit any part of said property to become subject to any taxes, assessments, liens, charges or incumbrances whatsoever having precedence over rights of the vondor in and to said property. Vendee shall be entitled to the possession of said property. Possession to be on November 15, 1975.

Vendor will on the execution hereof make and execute in favor of vendee good and sufficient warranty deed conveying a fee simple title to said property free and clear as of this date of all incumbrances whatsoever, except reservations, restrictions, easements and rights of way of record and those apparent upon the land; rules, regulations, liens and assessments of water users and sanitation districts.



together with one of these agreements in escrow at the First Federal Savings & Loan Association,

at Klamath Falls, Oregon, and shall enter into written escrow

instruction in form satisfactory to said escrow holder, instructing said escrow holder that when, and if, vendes shall have paid the balance of the purchase price in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract, said escrow holder shall deliver said instruments to vendee, but that in case of default by vendee said escrow holder shall, on demand, surrender

Escrow fees shall be deducted from the first payment made hereunder. The escrow holder may deduct cost of necessary

In the event vendee shall fail to make the payments aforesaid, or any of them, punctually and upon the strict terms and at the times above specified, or fail to keep any of the other terms or conditions of this agreement, time of payment and strict performance being declared to be the essence of this agreement, then vendor shall have the following rights: (1) To foreclose this contract by strict foreclosure in equity; (2) to declare the full unpaid balance immediately due and payable; (3) To specifically enforce the terms of this agreement by suit in equity; (4) To declare this contract null and vold, and in any of such cases, except exercise of the right to specifically enforce this agreement by suit in equity, all the right and interest hereby created or then existing in favor of vendee derived under this agreement shall utterly cease and determine, and the premises aforesaid shall revert and revest in vendor without any declaration of torfoliure or act of reentry, and without any other act by vendor to be performed and without any right of vendoe of reclamation or compensation for money paid or for improvements made, as absolutely, fully and perfectly as if this agreement had rever been made.

Should vendes, while in default, permit the premises to become vacant. Vender may take possession of same for the purpose of protecting and preserving the property and his security interest therein, and in the event possession is so taken by vendor he shall not be deemed to have waived his right to exercise any of the foregoing rights.

And in case suit or action is instituted to foreclose this contract or to enforce any of the provisions hereof, vendee agrees to pay reasonable cost of title report and title search and such sum as the trial court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees to be allowed plaintiff in said suit or action, and if an appeal is taken from any judgment or decree of such trial court, the vendee further promises to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as plaintiff's attorney's fees on

Vendee further agrees that failure by vendor at any time to require performance by vendoe of any provisions hereof shall in no way affect vendor's right hereunder to enforce the same, nor shall any waiver by vendor of such breach of any provision better the performance by vendoe of such breach of any provision to the provision itself.

In constraint this contract, it is understood that vendor or the vendee may be more than one person: that if the context so requires the singular pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural, the masculine, the feminine, and the neuter, and that generally all grammatical changes shall be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally appropriate and to individuals.

This agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as the circumstances may require, the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that the monthly payments made by the Vendee shall include taxes and insurance; the Vendor shall pay the taxes and insurance as they become due and add them back to the principal of this contract by presentation of paid receipts to the escrow holder herein. Said amounts so added to bear interest at the rate provided herein.

It is further agreed by the parties hereto that the Vendor herein shall have the right, upon written notice to the Vendee and to the escrow holder herein, to increase the monthly payments upon this contract to offset any increase in the taxes and/or insurance upon the above-described premises.
