QUITCLAIM DEED

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Regional Director, Mid-Pacific Region, Bureau of Reclamation, for the Secretary of the Interior, in pursuance of the Act of Congress approved June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388) and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, and particularly to the Act of Congress approved October 27, 1974, entitled Reclamation Development Act of 1974 (Title V, Public Law 93-493), which act authorized and directed the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain unneeded right of way of the United States to certain private landowners, does in consideration of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to it in hand paid, receipt of which is duly acknowledged, hereby quitclaim to Charles H. Hamilton and Violet Hamilton husband and wife, without warranty of title all of its right, title and interest in and to all that certain real property situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

Being all that portion of the 25-foot-wide strip of land described in that certain correction deed to the United States dated September 28, 1912, recorded in Book 38 at Page 209, filed in the records of Klamath County, State of Oregon, and lying within Lot 8, Old Orchard Manor, City of Klamath Falls, shown on the map filed May 20, 1941, in the Klamath County records.

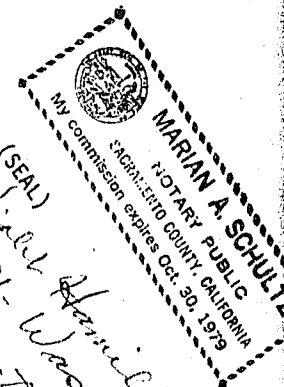

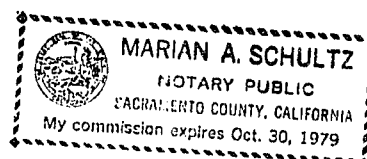
