To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting,

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a schedule of all tracts approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day of January, 1900, and January 1, 1901, whereby it

appears that the said tribe or band, has the following-described land:

The south half of the northeast quarter of Section thirty, -all four south and the north half of the southwest quarter of section thirty, thirty south all in Range eight east of the Willamette Meridian one hundred sixty acres.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, of the premises, has allotted, and by these presents does allot

the above-described and hereby declares that it does and will (subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions) for the sole use and benefit of the said tribe or band, and the United States will convey the same to the said tribe or band, and free from all charge and tax, and the said Indian, if he die before the expiration of the said trust, the said Indian does live before the expiration of said trust, the Secretary of the Interior shall ascertain the legal heirs of said Indian, and shall convey the same to the said heirs as provided by law. And there is hereby reserved a right of way thereon for ditches or canals, and the authority of the United States.
