AGREEMENT FOR EASEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 10th day of March, 1976, by and between Robert T. Morris and Jacqueline Morris hereinafter called the first party, and Round Lake Estates, Ltd., hereinafter called the second party;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS: The first party is the record owner of the following described real estate in Klamath County, State of Oregon, to-wit:

North Half of Section 7, T39S, R8E, Willamette Meridian

and has the unrestricted right to grant the easement hereinafter described relative to said real estate;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the premises and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1) by the second party to the first party paid and other valuable considerations, the receipt of all of which hereby is acknowledged by the first party, they agree as follows:

The first party does hereby grant, assign and set over to the second party a sewer line easement located in Section 7, T39S, R8E, W.M., Klamath County, Oregon being 16.00 feet in width lying 8.00 feet on either side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the north half of said Section 7 from which the southeast corner of said north half of Section 7 bears S89°55'26"E along said south line, 1641.49 feet; thence N00°06'47"E, 15.16 feet to a point; thence N02°03'21"E, 1327.56 feet to the south line of the sewage lagoon parcel and the terminus of this easement.

The second party shall have all rights of ingress and egress to and from said real estate (including the right from time to time, except as hereinafter provided, to cut, trim and remove trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions) necessary for the second party's use, enjoyment, operation and maintenance of the easement hereby granted and all rights and privileges incident thereto.

Except as to the rights herein granted, the first party shall have the full use and control of the above described real estate.

The second party hereby agrees to hold and save the first party harmless from any and all claims of third parties arising from second party's use of the rights herein granted.

The easement described above shall continue for a period of 99 years, always subject, however, to the following specific conditions, restrictions and considerations:

If this easement is for a right of way over or across first party's said real estate, the center line of said easement is described as follows:

and second party's right of way shall be parallel with said center line and not more than _____ feet distant from either side thereof.

This agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as the circumstances may require, not only the immediate parties hereto but also their respective heirs, executors, administrators and successors in interest as well.

In construing this agreement and where the context so requires, words in the singular include the plural; the masculine includes the feminine and the neuter; and generally, all changes shall be made or implied so that this instrument shall apply both to individuals and to corporations.
