MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- 2. Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolis provements now or hereafter existing to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction accordence with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;
- 7. To keep all buildings unceasingly insured during the term of the mortgage, against loss by fire and such other hazards in such company or companies and in such an amount as chall be satisfactory to the mortgagee; to deposit with the mortgagee all such policies with receipts showing payment in full of all premiums; all such insurance shall be made payable to the mortgagee; insurance shall be kept in force by the mortgager in case of foreclosure until the period of redemption expires;

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- 8. Mortgagee shall be entitled to all compensation and damages received under right of eminent domain, or for any country tarily released, same to be applied upon the indebtedness;
