PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a Maine corporation, successor in interest to THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, a California corporation, hereby releases and quitclaims to CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, an Oregon municipal corporation, all its right, title and interest arising out of that certain conveyance designated as "Grant of Right-of-Way" granted by F. H. McCornack and Rosa N. McCornack, husband and wife, Coleman F. O'Loughlin and Mary E. O'Loughlin, formerly Mary E. McCornack, husband and wife, and Agnes M. McCornack, unmarried, on July 13, 1925, and recorded in Volume 68, Page 281, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, insofar only as said right-of-way pertains to that portion of Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian, described as:

PARCEL I:

All of the platted area LYNEWOOD according to the official plat thereof on file in Records of Klamath County, situated in Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon.

PARCEL II:

Lots 3, 3B, 4, 4B, 20 and 57 of LAKE SHORE GARDENS to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof on file in the records of Klamath County, situated in Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon.

PARCEL III:

All of that portion of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, lying southerly and westerly of the plats of LYNEWOOD AND LAKE SHORE GARDENS.

All interests arising out of said instrument affecting other lands therein described shall remain vested in grantor, its successors and assigns.
