WHEREAS, Leo Sagehorn and Marie J. Sagehorn, husband and wife, granted to the United States of America, an easement for a road and that timber within the clearing limits as staked on the ground and designated for removal in road construction, dated June 12, 1972, and recorded in Klamath County, Oregon in Volume M 72, Page 6449, which easement contained the following provisions:

TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

If for a period of five (5) years the Grantee shall cease to use, or preserve for prospective future use, the road, or any Segment thereof, or if at any time the Regional Forester determines that the road, or any segment thereof, is no longer needed, the easement traversed thereby shall terminate. In the event of such nonuse or of such determination by the Regional Forester, the Regional Forester shall furnish to the Grantor a statement in recordable form evidencing termination.

WHEREAS, by easement dated April 21, 1976, recorded in Klamath County Deed Records, at Volume M 76, Page 6012, Leo Sagehorn and Marie J. Sagehorn, husband and wife, did grant to the United States of America an easement for the same road, over the lands of the Grantor,

WHEREAS, both Grantee and Grantor do intend and agree that the and easement subsequently granted shall supersede the aforesaid easeeasement subsequency granten shall supersene the aroresard easement dated June 12, 1972, and shall govern and control the rights of Grantee and Grantor for use of the lands and the roads thereon subject to such subsequent easement.

WHEREAS, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement dated June 12, 1972.

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement dated June 12, 1972, and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby cancelled.

THIS TERMINATION OF EASEMENT shall, however, have no effect on the rights granted to the United States of America by the easement the rights branted to the onited States of America by the easement dated April 21, 1976, all terms, provisions and conditions of which shall remain and be fully effective.
