The payments made by the Vendee shall include taxes and insurance; the Vendors shall pay the taxes and insurance as they become due and add them back to the principal of this contract by presentation of paid receipts to the escrow holder herein. Said amounts so added to bear interest at the rate provided herein.

Vendee agrees to make said payments promptly on the dates above named to the order of the vendor, or the

survivors of them, at the First Federal Savings & Loan Association, at Klamath Falls.

Escraw fees shall be deducted from the first payment made hereunder. The ascrow holder may deduct cost of nocessary revenue stamps from final payments made hereunder.

In the event vendes shall fail to make the payments aforesaid, or any of them, punctually and upon the strict terms and at the times above specified, or fail to keep any of the other torms or conditions of this agreement, time of payment and strict performance being declared to be the essence of this agreement, then vendor shall have the following rights: (1) To foreciose this contract by strict foreclosure in equity: (2) to declare the full unpaid balance immediately due and payable; (3) To specifically enforce the terms of this agreement by suit in equity: (4) To declare this contract null and void, and in any of such cases, except exercise of the right to specifically enforce this agreement by suit in equity, all the right and interest hereby created or then existing in favor of vendoe derived under this agreement shall utterly case and determine, and the premises aloresaid shall rovert and rovest in vendor without any declaration of torfeiture or act of reentry, and without any other act by vendor to be performed and without any right of vendee of reclamation or compensation for money paid or for improvements made, as absolutely, fully and perfectly as if this agreement had never been made.

Should vendee, while in default, permit the premises to become vacant, Vendor may take possession of same for the purpose of protecting and preserving the property and his security interest therein, and in the event possession is so taken by vendor he shall not be deemed to have waived his right to exercise any of the foregoing rights.

And in case suit or action is instituted to foreclose this contract or to enforce any of the provisions hereof, vendee agrees to pay reasonable cost of title report and title search and such sum as the trial court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees to be allowed plaintiff in said suit or action, and if an appeal is taken from any judgment or decree of such trial court, the vendee further promises to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as plaintiff's attorney's fees on such appeal.

Vendee further agrees that failure by vendor at any time to require performance by vendee of any provisions hereof shall in no way affect vendor's right hereunder to enforce the same, nor shall any waiver by vendor of such breach of any provision hereof be held to be a waiver of any succeeding breach of any such provision, or as a waiver of the provision itself.

In construing this contract, it is understood that vendor or the vendoe may be more than one person; that if the context so requires the singular pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural, the masculine, the feminine, and the neuter, and that generally all grammatical changes shall be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.

This agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as the circumstances may require, the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that there is a certain Trust Deed, including the terms and provisions thereof, given by Charles E. Whiting and Irene M. Whiting as grantors, to Transamerica Title Insurance Company, as trustee, for First National Bank of Oregon, as beneficiary, dated June 23, 1971, recorded June 23, 1971 in Vol. M-71 page 6524 Microfilm records of Klamath County, Oregon, to secure the payment of \$11,500, which Trust Deed Vendors shall pay and Vendors shall hold Vendee harmless from any obligation thereon.

It is further understood and agreed that Vendee shall not assign this contract without first obtaining consent of the Vendors, in writing.
