In the event the within described property, or any part thefeot, or any interest therein is sold, agreed to be sold, conveyed, assigned or alienated by the grantor without first having obtained the written consent or approval of the beneficiary, then, at the beneficiary's option, all obligations secured by this instrument, irrespective of the maturity dates expressed therein, or herein, shall become immediately due and payable.

The above described real property is not currently used for agricultural, timber or graxing purposes.

To protect the security of this trust deed, grantor agrees:

1. To protect, preserve and maintain said property in food condition and repair; not to remove or demolish any building or improvement thereon; not to commit or permit any waste of said property.

2. To complete or restore promptly and in food and workmanlike manner any building or improvement which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereon, and pay when due all costs incurred therefor.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; if the beneficiary so requests, to join in executing such innancing statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code as the beneficiary may require and to pay for liling same in the proper public office or offices, as well as the cost of all line scarches made by illing officers or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the heneficiary.

The provide and continuously maintain insurance on the buildings now or herekter crecked on the said premises against loss or damage by live and such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in an amount not less than \$\(\text{S}\). Such upplication or release shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

Trustee's lees for any of the services mentioned in this paragraph shall be not less than \$5.

Upon any default by grantor hereunder, beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receive to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property or any part thereof, in its own name sue or otherwise collect the tents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpuld, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including teasonable attorney's less upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as beneficiary may determine.
