WHEREAS, Weyerhaeuser Company granted to the United States of America an easement for fences, dated November 3, 1966, and recorded in Klamath County, Oregon, in Vol. M67, Page 680, which easement contained the following provisions:

All rights granted hereunder shall continue as long as used for the purpose granted, but if Grantee shall cease for a period of five (5) years to use the rights herein granted, or shall abandon the use of the easement herein granted, then said rights shall cease and determine and all rights shall revert to Weyerhaeuser.

WHEREAS, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need for said easement.

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby canceled.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America, by its Regional Forester, Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, has executed this instrument on this 11th day of January, 1977.

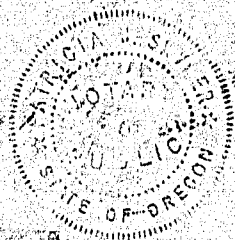
