Reneficiary shall pay to the grantor interest on sold amounts at a rate not less than the highest rate authorized to be paid by banks on their open passbook accounts minus 3/4 of 1%. If such rate is less than 4%, the rate of interest paid shall be paid quarterly to the grantor by crediting to the escrow account and shall be paid quarterly to the grantor by crediting to the escrow account the amount of the interest due.

While the grantor is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges belief or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin to bear interest and also to pay premiums on all insurance polities unon said property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary, as a foresaid. The grantor hereby authorizes the beneficiary to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levled or imposed against said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof furnished by the collector of such taxes, a sessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance carriers or their representatives and to withdraw the stame submitted by the insurance carriers or their representatives and to withdraw the stame which may be required from the reserve account, fany, established for that purpose. The grantor agrees in no event to hold the beneficiary responsibile for failure to law any insurance written or for any loss or damage growing out of a defect in any insurance policy, and the beneficiary hereby is authorized, in the event of any loss, to compromise and settle with any insurance company and to apply any such insurance receipts upon the obligations secured by this trust deed. 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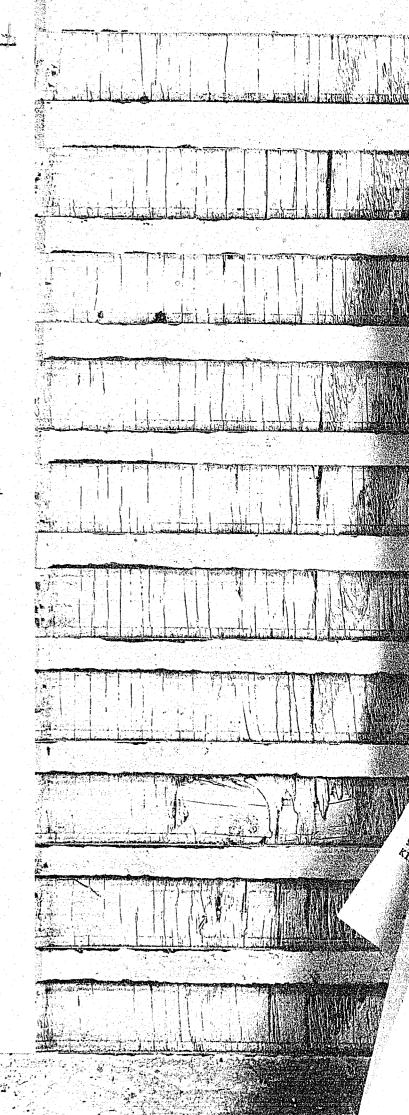
