WARRANTY DEED—TENANTS BY ENTIRETY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Lester D. Cordill and Dorothy M. Cordill, husband and wife

hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated to the grantor paid by Robert A. Carter and Elizabeth A. Carter

hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the grantees, as tenants by the entirety, the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 16, Block 3, Tract 1087, FIRST ADDITION TO BANYON PARK, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

Subject, however, to the following:

1. The premises herein described are within and subject to the statutory powers, including the power of assessment, of South Suburban Sanitary District.

2. Building setback line 25 feet from front of lot as shown on dedicated plat.

3. An 8 foot utility easement over rear portion of lot, as shown on dedicated plat.

4. Reservations and restrictions as shown on dedicated plat, to-wit:

"Subject to: (1) A 25 foot building setback on the front of all lots and a 20 foot building setback line along side street lines; (2)

Easements as shown on the annexed map for construction and maintenance (for continuation of this document see reverse side of this deed)

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said grantees, as tenants by the entirety, their heirs and assigns forever.

And grantor hereby covenants to and with grantees and the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances except as noted of record as of the date of this deed and those apparent upon the land, if any, as of the date of this deed, and that

grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 35,000.00
