INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

The court acquired jurisdiction of the respondent on Oct. 28, 1975 by:

The court orders that an interlocutory judgment be entered declaring that the parties are entitled to have their marriage dissolved. This interlocutory judgment does not constitute a final dissolution of marriage and the parties are still married and will be, and neither party may remarry, until a final judgment of dissolution is entered.

The court also orders that, unless both parties file their consent to a dismissal of this proceeding, a final judgment of dissolution be entered upon proper application of either party or on the court's own motion after the expiration of at least six months from the date the court acquired jurisdiction of the respondent. The final judgment shall include such other and further relief as may be necessary to a complete disposition of this proceeding, but entry of the final judgment shall not deprive this court of its jurisdiction over any matter expressly reserved to it in this or the final judgment until a final disposition is made of each such matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

1. Custody of the minor children shall be awarded to Petitioner with reasonable visitation to the Respondent. Respondent shall notify Petitioner of his intention to visit 48 hours in advance.
2. Petitioner is awarded as her sole and separate property the residence and household furnishings at 2398 Woolner Avenue in Fairfield, California.

3. Respondent is ordered to convey the real property located in Klamath Falls, Oregon to Petitioner. Petitioner is ordered to sell the said property and apply the proceeds to pay the community obligations at Well's Fargo Bank and at Aetna Finance Company.
4. If there are funds resulting from the sale of the Klamath Falls property in excess of the amount of the community obligations, those excess funds shall be divided equally between the parties. Petitioner may retain Respondent's share and that amount shall be subtracted from the lump sum owed Petitioner from Respondent's community property retirement benefits.
5. If there are community obligations remaining unpaid after all the proceeds of the sale of the Klamath Falls proper have been applied to the community obligations, the parties shall each be responsible for paying 1/2 the remaining amount owed by the community.
6. The Court finds that 1/6 of Respondent's retirement benefits from the United States Air Force are separate property; and 5/6 are community property, to be divided as follows: Respondent is ordered to pay 5/12 of each monthly payment to Petitioner. In addition, Respondent is ordered to pay to Petitioner on demand a lump sum equal to 5/12 the pension amounts paid to him since the parties separated in 1974.
7. Respondent shall pay \$100.00 per child per month as and for child support, pursuant to Civil Code §4702(a), to Solano County Probation Department, P.O. Box 969, Fairfield, California 94533 for so long as Petitioner receives AFDC; and shall pay \$100.00 per month per child pursuant to §4702(b) to Petitioner when she is not receiving AFDC.
8. Respondent shall pay \$75 per month spousal support to Petitioner.
9. Respondent shall pay \$150.00 in attorney's fees to the Solano County Legal Assistance Agency.
