The grantor agrees in no event to hold the beneficiary responsible for failure to have any insurance written or for any loss or damage growing out of a defect in any, insurance company and to apply any such insurance receipts upon the obligations secured by this trust cleed. 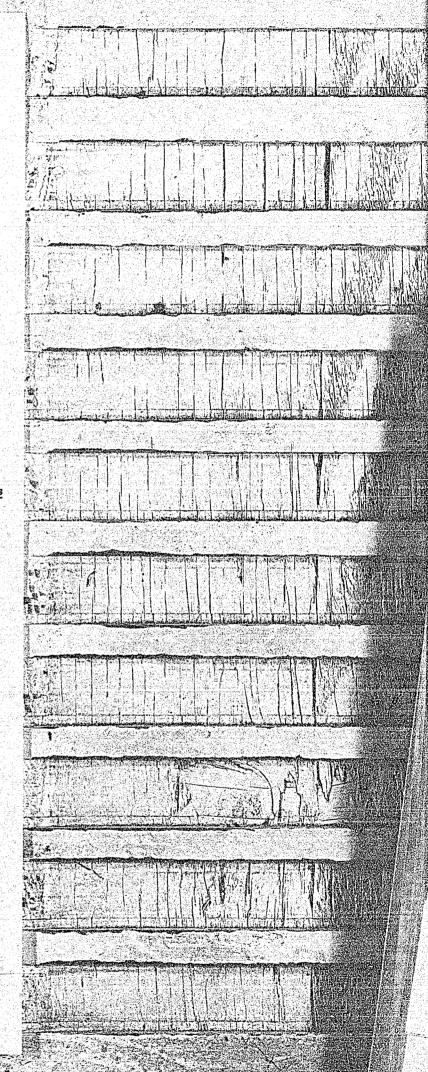
