FIRST: Each of us does hereby nominate and appoint the survivor of we two to serve as the executrix or executor of our respective estates and we hereby direct that no bonds shall be required of either in the performance of such duties. In the event we should both die in or as the result of a common disaster, or upon the death of the last of we two to die we hereby jointly and severally appoint our attorney, Forrest T. ELEVENTH: Each of us does hereby authorize and direct his executor or executrix to pay all State and Federal estate taxes out of the assets of the estate prior to making distribution to any devisee or legatee.

TWELFTH: In the event any executrix or executor nominated herein shall qualify to<sup>so</sup> serve, in any such event, we hereby jointly and severally authorize and empower such personal representative, to sell, dispose of and convey any and all



of our estate, real, personal and mixed, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, without being required to first obtain the approval of or the subsequent confirmation of any Court whatsoever, of public or private sale without giving or publishing any notice of such sale or sales, whenever in the judgment of such person it shall be advisable or judicious to do so, prior to the final settlement of my estate for the purpose of making settlement or distribution thereof or for any other necessary purpose, with full power to execute any and all necessary conveyances and to all acts necessary or expedient in carrying into effect the powers herein granted.
