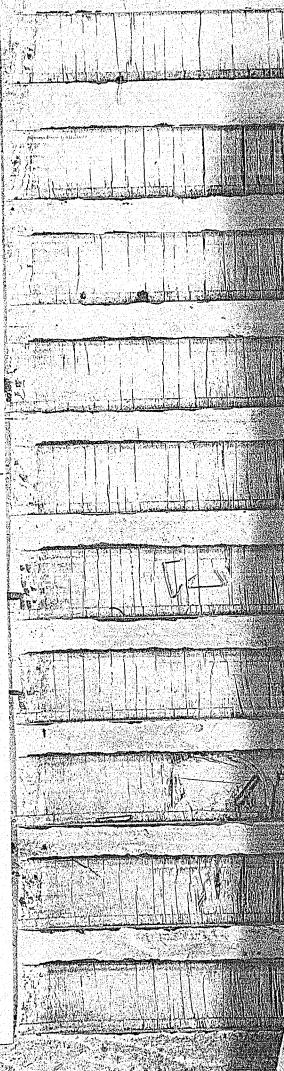
The grantor further agrees to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; to pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust, including the cost of title search, as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with or in enforcing this obligation, and trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred; to appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the sectify hereof or the rights or powers of the beneficiary or trustee; and to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees in a reasonable sum to be fixed by the court, in any such action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear and in any suit brought by beneficiary to foreclose this deed, and all said sums shall be secured by this trust deed.

The beneficiary will furnish to the grantor on written request therefor an annual statement of account but shall not be obligated or required to furnish any further statements of account.

It is mutually agreed that:

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1. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, the beneficiary shall have the right to commence, prosecute in its own name, appear in or defend any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement in connection with such taking and, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the money's payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's frees necessarily paid or incurred by proceedings, shall be paid to the beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and the grantor agreed at its own expense, to take such notions and execute such instruments as settled be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon the beneficiary's request.

After default and any time prior to five days before the date the Trustee for the Trustee's sale, the grantor or other person dileged may pay the entire amount then due under this trust deed obligations secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incured enforcing the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's exceeding \$50.00 each) other than such portion of the principal as we then be due had no default occurred and thereby cure the default.

- 9. When the Trustee sells pursuant to the powers provided herein, trustee shall apply the proceeds of the trustee's sale as follows: (1) the expenses of the sale including the compensation of the trustee, are casonable charge by the attorney. (2) To the obligation secured by trust deed. (3) Fo all persons having recorded liens subsequent to interests of the trustee in the trust deed as their interests appear in order of their priority. (4) The surplus, if any, to the grantor of the trideed or to his successor in interest cuttited to such surplus.
- 10. For any reason permitted by law, the beneficiary may from time to time appoint a successor or successors to any trustee named herein, or to any successor trustee appointed hereunder.
