RELEASE OF PORTION OF ACCESS ROAD EASEMENT RE-M-108

WHEREAS, on August 11, 1959, the United States of America acquired from WEYERHAEUSER TIMBER COMPANY, a Washington corporation, a perpetual Access Road Easement RE-M-108 which was recorded on September 8, 1959 in Volume 315, Page 446, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1962 the United States of America acquired from WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, a Washington corporation, a perpetual Correction Access Road Easement RE-M-108 recorded on January 29, 1962 in Volume 335, Page 263, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has determined that it no longer needs a portion of the right-of-way described in said Access Road Easement RE-M-108 for the operation, production, use or maintenance of property owned or controlled by the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, said portion of the right-of-way no longer needed is more particularly described as that portion lying in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW_4^1NW_4^3$ ), Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 5 East, and the Southwest Quarter (SW4), Section 30, Section 22, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the parcel of land to which the above description applies contains 1.01 acres, more or less, and

WHEREAS, the Service Center Director of the Bureau of Land Management has been delegated authority in BLM Manual \$ 1530.0385h to dispose of easements to the owners of the land which is subject to the easement in accordance with the terms of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, 40 U.S.C. § 471 et seq, and regulations contained in 41 CFR § 101-47.313-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the granting of those certain rights in RE-M-108a, dated March 24, 1977 and recorded in Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon in Volume M77 , Page 11586 , on June 30, 1977 , the United States of America does hereby abandon, relinquish and quitclaim to WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, a Washington corporation, all right, title and interest in that portion of RE-M-108 lying between approximate Engineer's Station 805+00.0 and Engineer's Station 808+00.0 and Engineer's Station 1016+21.0 and Engineer's Station 1027+50.0 as shown on the attached Exhibit A, pursuant to the above cited authority.
