## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned HARRY R.

WAGGONER and NORMA E. WAGGONER, husband and wife, as sellers, and

P. H. LEELING and ETHELDA LEELING, husband and wife, and G. C. MUSSELMAN,

JR. and MARCIA M. MUSSELMAN, husband and wife, as buyers, have entered

into an agreement of sale in writing under date of Tanc 15, 1977,

wherein sellers agreed to sell to buyers and buyers agreed to buy from

sellers the following-described real property, situated in Klamath

County, Oregon, to-wit:

A parcel of land situated in the NW\(^1\)SE\(^1\), Section 20,
Township 36 S., R. 9 E.W.M., being a portion of vacated
Blocks 8 and 9, ELDORADO HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City
of Klamath Falls, more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a 3/4 inch iron pipe marking the intersection of
the easterly line of Daggett Street and the northerly line
of Eldorado Boulevard; thence S. 89'16' E. along the
northerly line of Eldorado Boulevard 233.75 feet to a 3/4
inch iron pipe marking the beginning of a 40'41'15' curve
to the right and having a radius of 756.26 feet; thence
along the arc of said curve southeasterly, and slong the
northerly line of Eldorado Boulevard; 557.0 feet to an iron
pipe marking the most southerly corner of Lot 19, Block 8,
Eldorado Heights, now vacated; thence leaving the northerly
line of Eldorado Boulevard N. 41'26'44" E 110.0 feet to a
point on a curve which is parallel to, concentric and 110
feet distant radially from the northerstry right of way line
of Eldorado Boulevard; thence northwesterly along the
last-mentioned curve an arc distance of 451.05 feet, more
or less; to an iron pin on the westerly line of said Block 8,
now vacated; thence N. 73'553'50" W.60.85 feet to an iron
pln marking the northeasterly corner of Lot 14, Block 9, now
vacated; thence N. 89'47'50" W. 341.05 feet to an iron pin on the
easterly line of Daggett Street; thence S. 0'50'15" W., along
said.easterly line 10.0 feet to the point of beginning.

Block 8, Eldorado Heights Addition to the City of Klamath Falls,
Oregon, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning
at a 3/4 inch iron pipe marking the intersection of the
easterly li

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the northerly line of Eldorado Boulevard and along the arc of a 10°45'30" curve to the right having a radius of 756.26 feet, 142.0 feet to a point; thence leaving said northerly line N.30°21'05" E. 110.0 feet to a point on a curve which is parallel to; concentric and 110.0 feet distant radially from the northerly right of way line of Eldorado Roulevard; thence porthwesterly along the last Eldorado Boulevard; thence northwesterly along the last-mentioned curve an arc distance of 200.97 feet to the northeasterly corner of said parcel conveyed to the City of Klamath Falls; thence S. 0°47' W. along the easterly line of said parcel 115.69 feet to the true point of beginning.

RESERVING, HOWEVER, to sellers, their heirs and assigns, an easement for a geothermal or hot water pipe or line upon a strip of land 10 feet in width running along and parallel with the northeasterly boundary line of the above-described property.
