Klamath County Planning Findings of Fact and Order

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon on December 14, 1977, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Wayne Sorensen. The Hearings Reporter was Isabel Rodriguez.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners present who stated they had any objections to the proposed Variance requested by the applicant.

The hearing was then closed and based upon the evidence
submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following
findings of fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. There are exceptional cicumstances that apply to the subject property that do not apply generally to other property in the same vicinity in that it is of larger size and probably the only property in the immediate area that can be divided as such and because of the unique situation of having the owner of nearby commercial property who wishes to use it for a residence.
- 2. It is necessary to grant this Variance as requested for the preservation of the applicant's property right which is a right to sell his property and also be able to maintain a view.
- 3. There was no testimony in opposition to the proposed Variance, and there has been no suggestion that there would be any detrimental effect on the public health, safety, or welfare by granting this Variance.
- 4. The Variance requested is the minimum Variance which would alleviate the hardship.
- 5. The granting of this Variance would not allow use of the property not authorized within a particular zone.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

Variance 77-40, James Rogers That real property describes as the "Lots 24, 25, and 32, Township 35 South, Range 7, East of the Willamete Meridian, Section 28, Klamath County, Oregon" is hereby granted a Variance in accordance with, the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 17 and henceforth the required side yard setback requirements will be reduced from ten feet to five feet for the purpose of constructing a carport and workshop.
