together with the tenements, heriditaments, rights, privileges, and appurtenances including roads and casements used with the premises; electric wiring and fixtures; turnace and heating system, water heaters, fuel storage receptact ventilating, water and irrigating systems; screens, doors; window shades and blinds, shutters; cabinets, built-ins, linoleu coverings, built-in stoves, ovens, electric sinks, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers; and all fixtures now installed in or on the premises; and any shrubbery, flora, or timber now growing or hereafter planted or growing ther replacements of any one or more of the foregoing items, in whole or in part, all of which are hereby declared to be appuland, and all of the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged property;

(\$29,450.00----), and interest thereon, evidenced by the following promissory note:

I promise to pay to the STATE OF OREGON Twenty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Fifty and \$ 210.00----- on or before April 1, 1978-----successive year on the premises described in the mortgage, and continuing until the full amount of the principal, interest and advances shall be fully paid, such payments to be applied first as interest on the unpaid balance, the remainder on the principal. The due date of the last payment shall be on or before March 1, 1998----In the event of transfer of ownership of the premises or any part thereof, I will continue to be liable for payment and the balance shall draw interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 from date of such transfer. This note is secured by a mortgage, the terms of which are Dated at KLAMATH FALLS OR A. FARRIS

The mortgagor or subsequent owner may pay all or any part of the loan at any time without penalty.

The mortgagor covenants that he owns the premises in fee simple, has good right to mortgage same encumbrance, that he will warrant and defend same forever against the claims and demands of all pant shall not be extinguished by foreclosure, but shall run with the land.

MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS AND AGREES:

- 1. To pay all debts and moneys secured hereby;
- Not to permit the buildings to become vacant or unoccupied; not to permit the removal or demolishment of any buildings or improvements now or hereafter existing; to keep same in good repair; to complete all construction within a reasonable time in accordance with any agreement made between the parties hereto;
- 3. Not to permit the cutting or removal of any timber except for his own domestic use; not to commit or suffer any waste;
- 4. Not to permit the use of the premises for any objectionable or unlawful purpose;
- 5. Not to permit any tax, assessment, lien, or encumbrance to exist at any time;
- Mortgagee is authorized to pay all real property taxes assessed against the premises and add same to the principal, each of the advances to bear interest as provided in the note;

WANDA B. FARRIS

- Mortgegee shall be entitled to all compensation and damages received under right of eminent domain, or for any security voluntarily released, same to be applied upon the indebtedness;
- 9. Not to lease or rent the premises, or any part of same, without written consent of the mortgagee
- 10. To promptly notify mortgagee in writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any part or interest in same, and t furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer to the mortgagee; a purchaser shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 o all payments due from the date of transfer; in all other respects this mortgage shall remain in full force and effect.

The mortgagee may, at his option, in case of default of the mortgagor, perform same in whole or in part and all expanditure made in so doing including the employment of an attorney to secure compliance with the terms of the mortgage or the note shall draw interest at the rate provided in the note and all such expenditures shall be immediately repayable by the mortgagor without demand and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Default in any of the covenants or agreements herein contained or the expenditure of any portion of the loan for purposes other than those specified in the application, except by written permission of the mortgagee given before the expenditure is made, shall cause the entire indebtedness at the option of the mortgagee to become immediately due and payable without notice and this mortgage subject to foreclosure.

The failure of the mortgagee to exercise any options herein set forth will not constitute a waiver of any right arising from a breach of the covenants.

In case foreclosure is commenced, the mortgagor shall be liable for the cost of a title search, attorney fees, and all other costs incurred in connection with such foreclosure.

Upon the breach of any covenant of the mortgage, the mortgage shall have the right to enter the premises, take possession, collect the rents, issues and profits and apply same, less reasonable costs of collection, upon the indebtedness and the mortgagee shall have the right to the appointment of a receiver to collect same.

The covenants and agreements herein shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and ascigns of the respective parties hereto.
