## AGREEMENT TO ASSUME PAYMENTS AND HOLD HARMLESS

As and for partial consideration of Ronald M. Colitti and Anthony P. Colitti, hereinafter referred to as "Colitti," assigning to Jeld-Wen, Inc. their vendees interest in the following described real property, which said real property is a portion of that real property set out in that contract between John C. Horton, Robert L. Horton and Louisa L. harmless therefrom Accurate Electronics, Inc., Ronald M. Colitti, and Anthony P. Colitti. Also, Jeld-Wen, Inc. does hereby agree to become directly responsible and liable to Hortons for the balance of the above described payments, hereby making Hortons third party beneificaries to this agreement to assume payments and hold harmless.
