Dear Reverend Sirs:

As chairperson for the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Klamath County, it is my pleasant duty to advise you that under Section C 11.1 of the By-Laws, our Fellowship, on Sunday 12 March 1978, correctly called and ordained Mr. R. Severin Baldwin as our minister.

Mr. Baldwin's interest in our society predates mine so he has known some of our members since 1963. He has volunteered to fill the vacancy created by the out-of-state retirement of Mr. Joseph Russell. He is an energetic, mature man of principle, spiritual insight and with philosophical and theological interests. He has already conducted several services for us and recently presided at an emergency funeral. We know him to be demonstrably well qualified.

He is representing us as a ministerial delegate to the Klamath County Ministerial Association and has volunteered for the Community Hospital chaplaincy service. And he is in his 6th week of a 10 week counseling instruction given by ministers, psychologists and medics for our County Crisis Calls volunteers. He also has plans for interfellowship association in Southern Oregon and is interested in helping promote a Fellowship for Josephine County, Oregon, to be located at Grants Pass.

It is our hope that with his enthusiasm we can achieve, by next year, the minimum membership of 65 members. Mr. Baldwin will separately make application for admission as an associate probationary ministerial fellow.
