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Klamath County Planning FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on March 15, 1978, pursuant to notice given in conformity 9 with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before Klamath County 10 Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present accom-11 panied by Mrs. Patton. The Klamath County Planning Department was 12 represented by Carl Shuck. The Hearings Reporter was Isabel 13 14 Rodriquez.

15 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property 16 owners present who stated they had any objections to the proposed 17 Variance requested by the applicant. 18

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The hearing was then closed and based upon the evidence 2 submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following 3 findings of fact:

ANTER

FINDINGS OF FACT:

5 1. There are exceptional and extraordinary circumstances 6 applicable to the property involved which do not generally apply 7 to other property in the same vicinity and zone due to the unusual 8 topography of this particular piece of land.

9 2. The granting of the variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of the applicant's right to construct 10 an additional residence on his property; a right which is possessed 11 12 by other property owners in the same vicinity.

13 3. No one testified in opposition to the variance and the 14 there was no evidence that suggested that there would be any detrimental effect on the public health, safety and convenience 16 16 or welfare.

17 The requested Variance from 15 acres to a variance 4. 18 of one 5-acre parcel and a 10-acre parcel is the minimum variance which will alleviate the hardship. 19

20 The variance requested will not allow use of the 5 property for a purpose which is not authorized within the zone 21 22 which the property is located.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land generally located. near Olene, East of Crystal Springs Road, past the bridge at Olene Gap and more particularly located on Tax Lot 200, Section 22, Township 39 South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon."

Variance 78-1, Ray Patton Page 3

1 is hereby granted a Variance in accordance with the terms of the 2 Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 17 and henceforth the 15-acre parcel requirement for constructing a dwelling in the A (Agricul-tural) Zone will be reduced to one 5-acre parcel and one 10-acre parcel for the purpose of constructing a single family dwelling.
