4. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of rents, leases and profits or the proceeds of fire and other insurance, policies or compensation of losses for any loss or damage of the property, and the application or release thereof, or otherwise shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder, or invalidate any act done pursuant to such action.

5. The grantor shall notify beneficiary in writing of any sale or contract for sale of the above described property and furnish beneficiary with such personal information concerning the purchaser as would reasonably be required of a new loan applicant and shall pay beneficiary a service charge.

6. Time is of the essence of this instrument and upon default by the grantee in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in performance of any agreement hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable by delivery to the trustee of written notice of default and election to sell the trust property, which notice trustee shall cause to be duly filed for record. Upon delivery of said notice of default and election to sell, the beneficiary shall proceed with the trustee this trust deed and all promissory notes and documents evidencing indebtedness secured hereby, whereupon the trustee shall fix the time and place of sale and give notice thereof as then required by law.

7. After default and any time prior to five days before the date set privileged may pay the entire amount then due under this trust deed and to the obligations secured thereby (including costs and expenses lawfully incurred in enforcing the terms of this obligation and trustee's and attorney's fees not exceeding \$100.00), other than such portion of the principal sum as would then be due had no default occurred and thereby cure the default.

8. After the lapse of such time as may then be required by law following the receipt of said notice of default and giving of said notice of sale, the trustee shall sell said property at the time and place fixed by him in said notice of sale, either as a whole or in separate parcels, in such order as he may determine, at public auction to the highest bidder, or in such manner as the United States provides at the time of sale. Trustee may postpone sale of all or any portion of said property by public announcement several times and place of sale from time to time thereafter may postpone the sale by written es-

curement at the time fixed by the preceding postponement. The trustee shall deliver to the purchaser his deed in form as required by law, conveying the property so sold, but without any covenant or warranty, express or implied. The recital in the deed of any matter or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Any person, excluding the trustee but including the grantor and the beneficiary, may purchase at the sale.

9. When the Trustee sells pursuant to the powers provided herein, the trustee shall apply the proceeds of the trustee's sale as follows: (1) To the expenses of the sale including the compensation of the trustee, and a reasonable charge by the attorney. (2) To all persons having record title subsequent to the interests of the trustee in the trust deed as their interests appear in the order of their priority. (3) The surplus, if any, to the grantor of the trust deed or to his successor in interest entitled to such surplus.

10. For any reason permitted by law, the beneficiary may from time to time appoint a successor or successors to any trustee named herein, or to any successor trustee appointed hereunder. Upon such appointment and without conveyance to the successor trustee, the latter shall be vested with all title, powers and duties conferred upon any trustee herein named or appointed hereunder, and such appointment and substitution shall be made by written instrument executed record which, when recorded in the office of the county clerk or recorder of the county or counties in which the property is situated, shall be conclusive proof of proper appointment of the successor trustee.

11. Trustee accepts this trust when this deed, duly executed and acknowledged is made a public record, as provided by law. The trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other deed of trust or of any action or proceeding in which the grantor, beneficiary or trustee shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by the trustee.

12. This deed applies to, inures to the benefit of, and binds all parties hereto, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns. The term "Beneficiary" shall mean the holder and owner, including pledgee, of the note secured hereby, whether or not named as a beneficiary herein. In construing this deed and whenever the context so requires, the masculine gender includes the feminine and/or neuter, and the singular number includes the plural.
