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Klamath County Planning FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

8 A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on May 10, 1978, pursuant to notice given in conformity 9 with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before Klamath County 10 Hearings Officer, Del Parks. The applicant was present accompanied by Mr. Charles Dehlinger. The Klamath County Planning 12 Department was represented by Carl Shuck. The Hearings Reporter was Isabel Rodriguez.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and 16 on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners present who stated they had objections to the proposed Variance requested by the applicant.

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The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following 3 findings of fact:

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## FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. There is a ditch nearly in the center of the subject 5 6 property for irrigation purposes. It is an extraordinary circum-7 stance in that the natural and proper method in which to divide the piece of property would be on the ditch rather than to require 8 an arbitrary division that would make some of the property 9 unusable. This is an extraordinary circimstance not generally 10 applicable to other properties in the area, and other properties 11 12 in the area do not comply with the minimum lot size.

13 2. No one testified in opposition to the granting of the Variance, and there was no evidence which suggests that the 14 granting of the Variance would be detrimental to the public health, 15 16 safety, and welfare or injurious to other property improvements 17 in the area.

18 3. The proposed division is the minimum Variance re-19 quired to accomplish the purpose of the Variance.

**2**0 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings 21 of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcet of land lying eanterly of the Gale Lateral and approximately 5 miles east of the Town of Bonanza, west of the Gale Road and south of East Langell Valley Road and more particularly described as Government Lot 7, NEA NEA of Section 3, Township 40 South Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon"

Variance 78-13, Richard Vaughn Page 3  $1 \parallel$  is hereby granted a Variance in accordance with the terms of the 2 Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 17 and henceforth the required 20 acre minimum in an AF (Agricultural Forestry) Zone under Section 32.005 will be reduced to 17 acres on a parcel of the subject property.
