The applicant was present. The 1 ---------11 20 B.C Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Carl Shuck. 12 The Hearings Reporter was Isabel Rodriguez. 13 14 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. Variance 78-16, Donald Brehm

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FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The residential neighborhood in the subject area pre-existed the Zoning Ordinance and is actually a city type of neighborhood.

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2. The other houses in the area do not conform to any standard type of setback.

3. Because this is a residential area that utilizes individual septic systems rather than a municipal sewage treatment, 8 variations have to be made for the utilization of structures on 9 the property to accommodate the septic system. 10 11

4. No one testified in opposition and there was no evidence which would justify finding that the Variance would be 12 detrimental in any way to the public health, safety, convenience, 13 or welfare; in fact, the evidence suggests that the utilization 14 by the applicant would enhance not only his own property, but that 15 16 in the area. 17

5. The requested Variance is the minimum Variance necessary to alleviate the hardship that would be placed on the 18 19

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings 21 of Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 22

That real property described as the

"parcol of land approximately 7,350 square feet in size located in Stewart Lennox Subdivision and generally located on the corner of Fawn Avenue and Cortez Avenue, approximately 360 feet south of State Highway 66 and more particularly described as NE' SW% of Section 7, Tax Lot 1100, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon"
