The true and actual consideration for this transfer is Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100ths (\$19,900.00 DOLLARS.

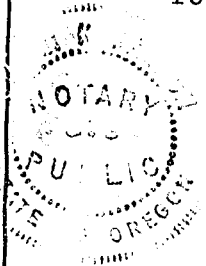
