...., hereinafter called the buyer, WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the seller agrees to sell unto the buyer and the buyer agrees to purchase from the seller all of the following de-

A parcel of land containing 4.40 acres, more or less, situated in the Northeast one-quarter of Section 1, Township 40 South, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron rod on the Range line between Ranges 7 and 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, being the Southeasterly corner of said parcel, from which the East 1/4 corner of Section 1 on the said Range line bears S 0003'59"E -- 1256.09

thence S 89°56'01"W -- 400.00 feet at right angles to the said Range line to a 5/8" iron rod;

thence N 00°03'59"W -- 479.08 feet and parallel to the said Range line to a 5/8" iron rod;

thence N 89°56'01"E -- 400.00 feet at right angles to the said Range line to a 5/8" iron rod on the said Range line;

thence S 0003'59"E -- 479.08 feet along the said Range line to the point of beginning.

Together with a non-exclusive easement, 16 feet wide, for ingress and egress over and across the following property: (continued on other side)

for the sum of Sixteen Thousand and Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$ 16,500.00 ) (hereinafter called the purchase price), on account of which Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$ 8,250.00 ) is paid on the execution hereof (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the seller); the buyer agrees to pay the remainder of said purchase price (to-wit: \$...\$8,250.00....) to the order of the seller in monthly payments of not less than Eighty one and 25/100 Dollars (\$ 81.25 ) each, ....

payable on the 15th day of each month hereafter beginning with the month of July , 19 78, and continuing until said purchase price is fully paid. All of said purchase price may be paid at any time; all deferred balances of said purchase price shall bear interest at the rate of ..... per cent per annum from 

the minimum monthly payments above required. Taxes on said premises for the current tax year shall be prorated between the parties hereto as of the date of this contract.

The buyer warrants to and covenants with the seller that the real property described in this contract is

\*(A) primarily for buyer's personal, lamily, household or agricultural purposes.

(B) for an organization or (even if buyer is a natural preson) is for business or commercial purposes other than agricultural purposes.

The buyer shall be entitled to possession of said lands of execution of this contract, and may retain such possession so long as he is not in default under the terms of this contract. The buyer agrees that at all times he will keep the buildings on said premises, now or hereafter erected, in good condition and repair and will not suffer or permit any waste or strip thereof; that he will keep and premises tree from mechanics and all other liens and save the seller harmless therefrom and reimburs seller for all costs and attorney's less incurred by him in defending against any such liens; that he will pay all taxes hereafter levied against said property, as well as all water rents, public charges and municipal liens which hereafter lawfully may be imposed upon said premises, all promptly before the same or any part thereof become past due; that at buyer's expense, he will insure and keep insured all buildings now or hereafter erected on said premises against loss or damage by fire (with extended coverage) in an amount

Appraised Value in a company or companies satisfactory to the seller, with loss payable first to the seller and then to the buyer as their respective interests may appear and all policies of insurance to be delivered to the seller as soon as insured. Now it the buyer shall fail to pay any such liens, costs, water rents, taxes, or charges or to procure and pay for such insurance, the seller may do so and any payment so made shall be added to and become a part of the debt secured by this contract and shall bear interest at the rate aloresaid, without waiver, however, of any right arising to the seller for buyer's breach of contract.

The seller agrees that at his expense and within 10 days from the date hereof, he will lurnish unto buyer a title insurance policy suring (in an amount equal to said purchase price) marketable title in and to said premises in the seller on or subsequent to the date of this agreeme save and except the usual printed exceptions and the building and other restrictions and easements now of record, if any. Seller also agrees that whe said purchase price is fully paid and upon request and upon surrender of this agreement, he will deliver a good and sufficient deed conveying a premises in lee simple unto the buyer, his heirs and assigns, free and clear of encumbrances as of the date hereof and free and clear of all encumbrances said date placed, permitted or arising by, through or under seller, excepting, however, the said easements and restrictions and the taxes, municipliers, water rents and public charges so assumed by the buyer and lur her excepting all liens and encumbrances created by the buyer or his assigns.
