(1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby accured and to indemnify and save harmless the Covernment against any loss ander its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. - (13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in any supplementary agreement are being performed.
- (14) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and igness and reamortize the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subordinate the lien hereof, and suive any other rights hereinder, without affecting the lien or priority hereof or the liability to the Government of Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby.
