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TRUST DEED

THIS TRUST DEED, made this 18day of MAY, 1978

STEVEN P. ALPERT AND EVELYN B. ALPERT, MRS. AND WIFE AS TENANTS IN THE ENTIRETY
TRANSAMERICA TITLE INSURANCE COMPANY, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION as Trustee, and WELLS FARGO REALTY
SERVICES, INC., A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, TRUSTEE as Beneficiary.

WITNESSETH:

Grantor irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to trustee in trust, with power of sale, the property in KLAMATH COUNTY, OREGON, described as:

Lot 19 in Block 19 of Tract 1113-Oregon Shores-Unit 2 as shown on the map filed on December 9, 1977 in Volume 21, Page 26 of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of said County.

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging or in anywise now or hereafter appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with said real estate.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING PERFORMANCE of each agreement of grantor herein contained and payment of the sum of (\$4,050)

FOUR THOUSAND, FIFTY

Dollars, with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to

beneficiary or order and made by grantor, the final payment of principal and interest hereof, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable June 20, 1989. The date of maturity of the debt secured by this instrument is the date, stated above, on which the final installment of said note becomes due and payable. In the event the within described property, or any part thereof, or any interest therein is sold, agreed to be sold, conveyed, assigned or alienated by the grantor without first having obtained the written consent or approval of the beneficiary, then, at the beneficiary's option, all obligations secured by this instrument, irrespective of the maturity dates expressed therein, or herein, shall become immediately due and payable.

The above described real property is not currently used for agricultural, timber or grazing purposes.

To protect the security of this trust deed, grantor agrees:

1. To protect, preserve and maintain said property in good condition and repair; not to remove or demolish any building or improvement thereon; not to commit or permit any waste of said property.

2. To complete or restore promptly and in good and workmanlike manner any building or improvement which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereto, and pay when due all costs incurred thereto.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions, and restrictions affecting said property; if the beneficiary so requires, to obtain in executing such financial statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code or in the beneficiary's opinion required, a copy of filing same in proper public office or offices as well as the cost of all such securities made by filing officers or searching officers as may be deemed desirable by the beneficiary.

4. To provide and continuously maintain insurance on the buildings now or hereafter erected on the said premises against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require in an amount not less than one hundred percent of the insurable value of the buildings, in companies acceptable to the beneficiary with loss payable to the latter; if the grantor shall fail to pay for any reason to procure any such insurance and to deliver said policies to the beneficiary at least fifteen days prior to the expiration of any policy of insurance now or hereafter placed on said buildings, the beneficiary may procure the same at grantor's expense. The amounts collected under any fire or other insurance policy may be applied by beneficiary upon any indebtedness secured hereby and in such order as beneficiary may determine. At option of beneficiary the entire amount so collected, or any part thereof, may be released to grantor. Such application or release shall not cure any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

5. To keep said premises free from construction, taxes and all pay all taxes, assessments and other charges that may be levied or assessed upon or against said property before any part of such taxes, assessments and other charges become past due or delinquent and promptly deliver receipt therefor to beneficiary; should the grantor fail to make payment of any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, items or charges payable by grantor, either by direct payment or by providing option payment with funds with which to make such payment, beneficiary may, at its option, make the same secured hereby, and the amount so paid, with interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby, together with the obligations described in paragraph 6 and 7 of this trust deed shall be added to and become part of the debt secured by this trust deed, without waiver of any rights arising from breach of any of the covenants hereof; and as far as the grantor, shall be bound to the same extent as they are bound for the payment of the obligation herein described, the property hereinbefore described, as well as the grantor, shall be bound to the same extent as payments shall be immediately due and payable without notice and the nonpayment thereof shall, at the option of the beneficiary, render all sums secured by this trust deed immediately due and payable and constitute a breach of this trust deed.

6. To pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust including the cost of title search as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with this obligation.

7. To appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security rights or powers of beneficiary or trustee; and in any suit, action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear, including any suit for foreclosure of this deed, to pay all costs and expenses, including evidence of title and the beneficiary's or trustee's fees provided, however, in case the suit is brought by the attorney's fees herein described, the prevailing party shall be entitled to the attorney's fees herein described; the amount of attorney's fees mentioned in this paragraph 7 in all cases shall be fixed by the trial court or by the appellate court if an appeal is taken.

It is mutually agreed that:

8. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, beneficiary shall have the right, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the monies payable at compromise for such taking, which are in excess of the amounts required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessarily incurred by grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to beneficiary and, if so paid by grantor upon any reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees, both in the trial and appellate courts, necessary paid or incurred by beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the indebtedness secured hereby; and grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon beneficiary's request.

9. At any time, from time to time upon written notice of beneficiary, payment of its fees and compensation of this deed and the note for enforcement (in case of full reconveyance for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, trustee may (a) consent to the leasing of any map or plot of said property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any

The grantor covenants and agrees to and with the beneficiary and those claiming under him, that he is lawfully seized in fee simple of said described real property and has a valid, unencumbered title thereto.

NOTE: The Trust Deed Act provides that the trustee hereunder must be either an attorney, who is an active member of the Oregon State Bar, a bank, trust company or savings and loan association authorized to do business under the laws of Oregon or the United States, a title insurance company authorized to insure title to real property of this state, its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents or branches, or the United States or any agency thereof.

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and that he will warrant and forever defend the same against all persons whomsoever.

The grantor warrants that the proceeds of the loan represented by the above described note and this trust deed are:
 (a) primarily for grantor's personal, family, household or agricultural purposes (see Important Notice below),
 (b) for an organization, or (even if grantor is a natural person) are for business or commercial purposes other than agricultural
 purposes.

This deed applies to, inures to the benefit of and binds all parties hereto, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, personal representatives, successors and assigns. The term "beneficiary" shall mean the holder and owner, including pledgee, of the contract secured hereby, whether or not named as a beneficiary herein. In construing this deed and whenever the context so requires, the masculine gender includes the feminine and the neuter, and the singular number includes the plural.


