SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT

THIS Satisfaction of Judgment made this 22 day of August,  
1978, between Patricia M. Crim hereinafter referred to as Wife and  
Wilbur E. Crim, hereinafter referred to as Husband, both of Klamath  
County, State of Oregon.

W I T N E S S E T H :

THAT the parties hereto are husband and wife. That a Petition  
for Dissolution of Marriage have been filed in Klamath County Circuit  
Court, No. 77-701E. That a Decree of Dissolution of Marriage was  
entered on the 21st day of July, 1978. That on the 3rd day of August,  
1978, Husband filed a Notice of Appeal to the Court of Appeals of the  
State of Oregon. Thereafter, Husband and wife had privately discussed  
the matters involved and now wish to fully and fairly settle and agree  
upon their respective rights to property distribution and satisfaction  
of the judgment rendered by the Decree on the 21st day of July, 1978.

IT IS THEREFORE, MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1 That in consideration of deeding real property which is marked  
2 as Exhibit "A", attached and incorporated herein, by Husband to Wife,  
3 and other considerations stated herein which are as follows:

4 1. That Husband shall retain as his sole and separate property,  
5 numerous items of household furniture and appliances which he has in  
6 his possession at Star Route Box 79, Chiloquin, Oregon.

7 2. Husband shall retain as his sole and separate property, free  
8 of any claims of the Wife, that 1976 Ford pickup truck, Beaver Camper  
9 and horse trailer, as well as numerous articles of farm machinery  
10 which he has in his possession on his property at Star Route Box 79  
11 Chiloquin, Oregon.

12 3. That husband shall have as his sole and separate property  
13 that certain real property the legal description of which is as  
14 follows:

15 A parcel of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 30 T  
16 35 S, R 7 E, WM, Klamath County, Oregon, more part-  
17 icularly described as thus: Beginning at a point  
18 along the center line of county road to a point;  
19 thence S 8 07'E 30' to the true point of begin-  
20 ning. Thence S 8 07'E 935' to the westerly bank  
21 of the Williamson River. Thence N 41 01'E 1226.6'  
22 more or less to a point of Westerly bank of said  
23 river; thence West 422.8' to North Easterly right  
24 of way of State Hiway 427. Thence West 116' to the  
25 South Westerly right of way of said hiway; thence  
26 west 266.2' along center line of said county road  
to a point; thence S 8 07'E 30' to the true point  
of beginning, containing 6 acres more or less.  
Excepting therefrom the legal description of Exhibit "A".  
free from any and all claims, liens and judgments of Wife.

4. Wife shall have the following mares: "Molly", "Peppermint  
Patty" and "Honey" together with all tack and saddles belonging to  
said mares.

1 5. Wife shall have as her sole property, one pair of bunk beds  
2 complete with linens.

3 6. Wife shall have, free and clear of claims of Husband, the  
4 1973 Thunderbird automobile.

5 7. Wife shall pay the attorneys fees of her attorney, awarded  
6 by the Court in the Decree dated July 21, 1978.

7 Further, the civil suit which is entitled Wilbur E. Crim vs.  
8 Patricia M. Crim, Klamath County Case No. 77-267L, shall be dismissed  
9 by both parties with prejudice. Husband shall dismiss his Notice  
10 of Appeal.

11 That the parties hereto acknowledges that he and she has read  
12 the foregoing instrument, fully understands the same and the same is  
13 fair and equitable and is a complete disposition of their property  
14 rights under the Decree rendered by the Circuit Court Judge, Donald  
15 A. W. Piper on the 21st day of July, 1978.

16 Husband shall execute a Motion for Dismissal of the civil suit  
17 and Wife shall execute a Motion for Dismissal of her Counter-suit  
18 in the case 77-267L. Wife shall execute a Satisfaction of Judgment  
19 a copy of which is attached hereto and Wife shall execute a Quit  
20 Claim Deed conveying any and all interest she may have against the  
21 husband by virtue of the Decree rendered on July 21, 1978. Both  
22 parties shall execute titles of the motor vehicles hereinabove stated  
23 for the purpose of placing the motor vehicles in their individual  
24 names.

25 Wife acknowledges that the deeding of the property described in  
26 Exhibit "A" which is attached and incorporated herein, by Husband to
