A SPECIAL ORDINANCE VACATING THAT DEDICATED ALLEY LYING IN BLOCK 4 OF THE HOT SPRINGS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on May 8, 1978, and after considering all testimony and evidence voted to recommend vacation of the specified alley; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council held a public hearing on June 19, 1978, and after considering all testimony and evidence determined that it is in the best interests of the City that the specified alley be vacated, now therefore.

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That dedicated alley lying in Block 4 of the Hot Springs Addition to the City of Klamath Falls be vacated, as depicted on the attached map marked Exhibit "A".

Section 2.

A sum of \$800.00 shall be paid to the City by Klamath Publishing Co., in satisfaction of City Charter Section 42.
