hereunto, make, seal and subscribe and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint

my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead and for any use and benefit,
to do all such acts and things, and to have and to keep such and any use and benefit,

(1) To sue in all places, actions, causes, and matters, civil, criminal, admiralty, marine, revenue and diverse of
any kind or nature of property of which I am now or hereafter may be possessed or in which I may have any
right, title or interest, including rights of attachment, for any price or sum and upon such terms and conditions
as to my said attorney may appear proper;

(2) To sue in all places, manage, administer, operate, renew and recover any and all real or personal
property now or hereafter belonging to me, to pay the expenses thereof, to lease and buy the same leased and
to pay any and all taxes, charges and assessments that may be levied or imposed upon any thereof;

(3) To sue in all and generally drift in and with goods, wares and merchandises of every nature, colors
and descriptions and to appropriate, pledge and consecrate the same;

(4) To sue in all places, manage, renew and deliver all or any share of stock in any corporation
for any price or sum such sums as to my said attorney may appear right and proper and to receive and
make payment thereof;

(5) To sue in all places of equity for such terms and at such rate of interest as to my said attorney may
appear proper and to give security for the payment of the same;

(6) To sue in all places, recover, and collect all money, debts, rents, dues, amounts, expenses,
bills, accounts, damages and other whatsoever which are due or which lawfully may become due, owing
and payable or standing as sum and as there, one and take all lawful ways and means in my power for the


