Dear Mr. Norton:

Please use this letter as your permit to operate an 8" irrigation pipeline across the West Langel Valley Road located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, T. 39 S., R. 11 E., H.M. The irrigation pipe must remain encased inside a 12" corrugated metal pipe in accordance with your present installation. This permit pertains to your present installation only and will remain in affect so long as it does not damage the road or interfere with County maintenance within the road right-of-way.

Klamath County will not grant an easement across a public road right-of-way. We operate on a permit system which allows an individual to place installations within the road right-of-way with the County maintaining jurisdiction as required by State Statutes.
