NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That
claims of lien upon the crops of rye hay

and the following described animals

grown in the year 1978 upon the following described farmland, range, ranch, orchard land or in claimant's place
of business situated in Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit:

That part of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ that lays
North of Sprague River Highway and that part
of W $\frac{1}{2}$ of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ that lays North of
Sprague River Highway and E $\frac{1}{2}$ of E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$
and E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ S11, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 35
South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Said lien also is claimed upon the proceeds of the sale of any or all of said crops and animals. For brevity, the
crops and/or animals charged with this lien hereinafter are called chattels.

ticularly described) by claimant at the request and for the benefit of the owner of said chattels to aid the growing or
harvesting of crops and for the raising of livestock upon the land described above; the words "performs labor or pro-
vides services," "materials," "growing and harvesting" and "raising animals" as used in this lien have the meaning
ascribed to them in Section 18 of Chapter 644, Oregon Laws 1975, to which reference hereby is made.

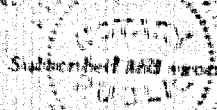
