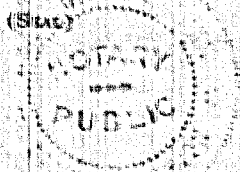

The foregoing Loggers and Woodworkers Lien is authorized by Section 17 of Chapter 449, Oregon Laws 1975; Section 21 of said chapter provides in part:

"(1) A person claiming a lien created by sections 18 to 19 of this Act shall file a written notice of claim of lien with the recording officer of the county in which the lien debtor resides, or, if the lien debtor is a business, the county in which the lien debtor has its principal place of business not later than 60 days after the close of the month of the filing, as shown in subsection 2 of this section."

Sections 23 and 24 of said Chapter 449 provide:

"Section 23: The recording officer of the county shall record the notices filed under section 21 of this Act in a book kept for that purpose and called 'Index of Liens upon Chattels'."

"Section 19: When a lien claimant files a notice of claim of lien as required by section 21 of this Act, he shall send forthwith a copy of the notice to the owner of the chattel to be charged with the lien by registered or certified mail sent to him at his last-known address."
