The foregoing Notice of Lien is authorized by Sections 17 of Chapter 449, Oregon Laws 1975; Section 21 of said chapter provides in part:

"(1) A person claiming a lien created by section 18 of this Act shall file a written notice of claim of lien with the recording officer of the county within the time hereby provided or, if the lien is a lien of a business, the county in which the lien debtor has its principal place of business not later than 60 days after the close of the running of the lien, against or againsts it is a lien."

Section 22 and 23 of said Chapter 449 provide:

Section 22: The recording officer of the county shall keep the notices filed under section 21 of this Act in a book kept for that purpose and called a book of lien notices.

Section 23: When a lien debtor files a written notice of lien as required by section 21 of this Act, he shall send forthwith a copy of the notice to the owner of the chattel on which the lien is claimed or, if no owner is named, to the person who has the last known address.
