The foregoing Loggers and Woodworkers Lien is authorized by Section 12 of Chapter 848, Oregon Laws 1975; Section 21 of said chapter provides in part:

"§ 21. A person claiming a lien created by sections 28 to 30 of this Act shall file a written notice of claim of lien with the recording officer of the county in which the lien debtor resides, or, if the lien debtor is a business, the county in which the lien debtor has its principal place of business not later than 60 days after the closing of the logging or the work on materials to which it applies."

Section 22 and 23 of said Chapter 848 provide:

"Section 22. The recording officer of the county shall index the notices filed under section 21 of this Act in a book kept for that purpose and called 'Index of Liens upon Chattels'."

"Section 23. When a lien claimant files a notice of claim of lien as required by section 21 of this Act, he shall send forthwith a copy of the notice to the owner of the chattels to be charged with the lien by registered or certified mail sent to him at his last-known address."
