

ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned pursuant to an Order issued out of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lane County, In the Matter of the Estate of Viola S. Casebier in and to that certain contract for the sale of real estate dated April 1, 1961, between Viola S. Casebier and H. C. Casebier, wife and husband, as first party, and Earl A. 
