This approval is given on the basis that the lot or parcel described above will not be further partitioned or subdivided and that conditions on subject or adjacent properties have not been altered in any manner which would prohibit issuance of a permit under the statutes and rules noted above. Any such subdivision, partitioning or alteration voids this certificate. ion blos cood sast so The subsurface sewage disposal system is to be located on the above-described property as follows: 1. A construction permit must be obtained from this office before this system is installed. 2. Test holes examined on May 17, 1978, revealed pumice. 3. Minimum drainfield and replacement area setbacks are 100 feet from all wells, and 10 feet from property lines. 4. An equal sized area for drainfield replacement must be reserved on the property and be kept free from development. 5. Drainfield trenches are not to exceed 30 inches in depth because of the rapidly draining soil conditions. 6. This drainfield must be an equal distribution system (see attached). 7. lineal feet of drainfield line are required per bedroom. 8. A 1,000 gallon septic tank should be used for this system. 9. Persons other than the property owner must be licensed to install the system. 10. Please provide your installer with a copy of this letter. 11. You must call this office to inspect the system before covering. A system to be located anywhere on the lot or parcel other than as described above will require an additional site evaluation along with an additional fee. This certification is valid until a subsurface sewage disposal system is installed pursuant to a permit ed from Klamath Falls Branch or until earlier cancellation, pursuant to Commission rules, with written notice thereof by the Department of Environmental Quality to the then owners according to Department records or the county tax records, whichever are more current.
