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THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the appli-6 cation of Paul Faircio, for a Comprehensive Land Use Plan change 7 from Agriculture to General Commercial and Zone Change from 8 9 AF (Agriculture Forestry) to C-5 (Commercial Highway) on real 10 property described as being in Section 36, Township 39, Range 9, 11 in Klamath County, Oregon, with said property being approximately 12 23 acres in size, was heard before the Planning Commission on 13 August 8, 1978 and August 22, 1978, wherefrom the testimony, re-14 ports and information produced at the hearing by the Applicant, 15 the Planning Department Staff, and other persons in attendance, 16 the Planning Commission recommended disapproval of the application to the Board of County Commissioners. Following actions by the 17 18 Planning Commission, a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was held on October 3, 1978 and November 21, 1978, 19 wherefrom the testimony, reports and information on the record 20 below, the Board of County Commissioners voted to approve Compre-21 hensive Land Use Plan change and Zone Change 78-27 for Pual Fair-22 23 elo.

Testimony indicated that agriculture uses were in the area and therefore this in effect would be spot zoning. 15 16 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW: 17 1. The proposed change in the Comprehensive Land Use Plan and zone would have an adverse effect on surrounding proper-18 19 20 2. The proposed use is not in keeping with land uses 21 and trends in land development. 22 3. Proposed use is not in keeping with the type of need for development in the affected area. 23 24 4.
