1. Testimony indicated that area for change in Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Change that this was a Deer Winter 8 9 10

2. Testimony indicated that there was no fire district within the nearby area. 11 12

3. Testimony indicated that area for change in Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone, which is later to be subdivided 13 that the Bonanza School was overcrowded. 14 15

4. Testimony indicated that this type of zone change would be spot zoning. 16 17

5. Testimony from applicant indicated that there was 18 no need shown for such development in this area.
