(\$32,850.00 | Dollars, with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith mayable to the beneficiary or order and made by the grantor, principal and interest being payable in monthly installments of \$ 308.10 February 20 19 79.

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This trust deed shall further secure the payment of such additional money, if any, as may be loans? hereafter by the beneficiary to the grantor or others having an interest in the above described property, as may be evidenced by note or notes. If the indebtedness secured by this trust deed is evidenced by more than one note, the beneficiary may credit payments received by it upon any of said notes or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the beneficiary may elect.

The grantor hereby covenants to and with the trustee and the beneficiary herein that the said premises and property conveyed by this trust deed are free and clear of all encumbrances and that the grantor will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend his said title thereto against the claims of all persons whomsoever.

The grantor covenants and agrees to pay said note according to the terms thereof and, when due, all taxes, assessments and other charges levied against said property; to keep said property free from all encumbrances having precedence over this trust deed; to complete all buildings in course of construction or hereafter constructed on said premises within six months from the date hereof or the date construction is hereafter commenced; to repair and restore promptly and in good workmanlike manner any building or improvement on said property which may be damaged or destroyed and pay, when due, all costs incurred therefor; to allow beneficiary to inspect said property at all times during construction; to replace any work or materials unsatisfactory to beneficiary within fifteen days after written notice from beneficiary of such fact; not to remove or destroy any building or improvements now or hereafter erected upon said property in good repair and to commit or suffer now waste of said premises; to keep all buildings, property and improvements now or hereafter erected upon said promises continuously insured against loss by fire or such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in a sum not less than the original principal sum of the note or obligation secured by this trust deed, in a company or companies acceptable to the beneficiary and to deliver the original policy of insurance in correct form and with approved loss payable clause in favor of the beneficiary attached and with premium paid, to the principal place of business of the beneficiary at least lifteen days prior to the effective date of any such policy of insurance. If said policy of insurance is not so tendered, the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary may in the own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary the heneficiary and in favor of the beneficiary which insurance shall be non-cancellable by the grantor during the full term of the poli

That for the purpose of providing regularly for the prompt payment of all taxes, assessments, and governmental charges levied or assessed against the above described property and insurance premium while the indebtedness secured hereby is in excess of 80% of the lesser of the original purchase price paid by the grantor at the time the loan was made or the heneficiary's original appraisal value of the property at the time the loan was made, grantor will pay to the heneficiary in addition to the mentily payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note or obligation secured hereby on the date installments on principal and interest are payable an amount equal to 1/12 of the taxes, assessments, and other charges due and payable with respect to said property within each succeeding 12 months and also 1/36 of the insurance prentum payable with respect to said property within each succeeding three years while this Trust Deed is in effect as estimated and directed by the beneficiary. Beneficiary shall pay to the grantor interest on said amounts at a rate not less than the highest rate authorized to be paid by banks on their open passbook accounts minus 3/4 of 1%. If such rate is less than 4%, the rate of interest paid shall be 4%. Interest shall be computed on the average monthly balance in the account and shall be paid quarterly to the granter by crediting to the escrow account the amount of the interest due.

While the granter is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges ledel or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin to hear interest and also to pay premiums on all insurance policies upon said property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary, as aforesaid. The granter bereby authorizes the beneficiary to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges ledel or imposed against said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof furnished by the collector of such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance prendum in the amounts shown on the statements submitted by the insurance carriers or indicting the first paying the insurance carriers or indicting the collection. In the amounts shown on the statements submitted by the insurance carriers or heir rep-resentatives and to withdraw the sums which may be required from the reserve account, if any, established for that purpose. The granter agrees in no event to hold the beneficiary responsible for failure to have any insurance written or for any loss or damage growing out of a defect in any insurance policy, and the beneficiary kereby is authorized, in the event of any loss, to compromise and settle with any insurance company and to apply as such insurance receipts upon the obligations accured by this trust deed, in computing the amount of the indebtedness for payment and satisfaction in full or upon sale or other

acquisition of the property by the beneficiary after default, any balance remaining in the reserve account shall be credited to the indebtedness. If any authorized reserve account for taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges is not sufficient at any time for the payment of such charges as they become due, the grantor shall pay the defleit to the beneficiary upon demand, and if not paid within ten days after such demand, the beneficiary may at its option add the amount of such deflex to the principal of the obligation secured hereby.

Should the grantor fail to keep any of the foregoing covenants, then the beneficiary may at its option carry out the same, and all its expenditures therefor shall draw interest at the rate specified in the note, shall be repayable by the grantor on demand and shall be secured by the lien of this trust deed. In this connection, the heneficiary shall have the right in its discretion to complete any improvements made on said premises and also to make such repairs to said property as in its sole discretion it may deem necessary or advisable.

The grantor further agrees to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; to pay all coats, fees and expenses of this trust, including the cost of title search, as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with or menforcing this obligation, and trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred; to appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof or the rights or powers of the beneficiary or trustee; and to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees in a reasonable sum to be fixed by the court, in any such action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear and in any sult brought by beneficiary to foreclose this deed, and all said sums shall be secured by this trust deed.

The beneficiary will furnish to the grantor on written request therefor an inl statement of account but shall not be obligated or required to furnish further statements of account.

It is mutually agreed that:

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 1. In the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, the beneficiary shall have the right to commence, prosecute in its own name, appear in or defend any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement in connection with such taking and, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the money's payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's free necessarily paid or incurred by the grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to the beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and the grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall he necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon the beneficiary's request.
- 2. At any time and from time to time upon written request of the beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, the trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating and restriction thereon, (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lien or charge hereof; (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto" and the recitais therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's fees for any of the services in this paragraph shall be \$5.00.

 As additional accurity, grantor hereby assigns to beneficiary during the continuance of these trusts all rents, leaves, royalities and profits of the preperty affected by this deed and of any personal property located thereon. Until grantor stall default in the payment of any indicatedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement hereunder, grantor shall have the right to collect all such rents, issues, royalities and profits earned prior to default as they hecome due and payable. Upon any default by the grantor hereunder, the baseficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of say security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of anid property, or may part thereof, in its own name sue for or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less coxis and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable afterner's fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as the herefulary may determine.

- 4. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of the property, and the application or release thereof, as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.
- 5. The grantor shall notify beneficiary in writing of any sale or contract for sale of the above described property and furnish beneficiary on a form supplied it with such personal information concerning the purchaser as would ordinarily be required of a new loan applicant and shall pay beneficiary a service charge.
- 6. Time is of the essence of this instrument and upon default by the grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in performance of any agreement hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable by delivery to the trustee of written notice of default and election to sell the trust property, which notice trustee shall cause to he aduly filed for record. Upon delivery of said notice of default and election to sell, the beneficiary shall deposit with the trustee this trust deed and all promissory the notes and documents evidencing expenditures accured hereby, whereupon the notes shall fix the time and place of sale and give notice thereof as then required by law.
- 7. After default and any time prior to five days before the date set by the Trustee for the Trustee's sale, the grantor or other person so privileged may pay the entire amount then due under this trust deed and the obligations secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incurred the obligation secured the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's fees in enforcing the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's fees in enforcing \$50.00 each) other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred and thereby cure the default.
