ORDER

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the appli-6 cation of T.D. Jackson for a Zone Change from AF (Agricultural-7 Forestry) to A (Agricultural), by the Klamath County Planning 8 Commission, on real property described as Township 39S, Range 10 9 EWM, Section 31. Public hearings having been heard by the 10 Klamath County Planning Commission on November 28, 1978 and 11 December 5, 1978, wherefrom the testimony, reports, and informa-12 tion produced at the hearing by the applicant, members of the 13 Planning Department Staff and other persons in attendance, the 14 Planning Commission recommended approval to the Board of County 15 Commissioners. Following action by the Planning Commission, a 16 public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was 17 regularly held on January 16, 1979, wherefrom the testimony at 18 said hearing it appeared that the record below was accurate and 19 complete and it appears from the testimony, reports and exhibits 20 introduced at the hearing before the Planning Commission that the 21 application for a Zone Change for the subject property, should be 22 granted. 23

24The Board of County Commissioners makes the following25Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required by Ordinance26No. 17, the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The Board of Commissioners found proposed site for

The Board of Commissioners found site for change 12 of zone was in conformance with the existing land use plan, 13 that being Agriculture and the land is agricultural itself, thus 14 addressing L.C.D.C. Goal No. 3, Agriculture. 15 The Board of Commissioners found site for change 6. 16 of zome that there is water available which would be by well. 17 7. The Board of Commissioners found that Department 18 of Environmental Quality will determine septic tank suitability, 19 thus addressing L.C.D.C. Goal No. 6, Air, Water and Land Resources 20 Quality. 21 22 8. The Board of Commissioners found that there are adequate public facilities for fire protection, electricity, 23 school.and telephone, thus addressing L.C.D.C. Goal No. 11, Publid 24 Facilities and Services. 25 The Board of Commissioners found proposed site 26 9. for change of zone had access onto Highway 39, Klamath Falls-27 Merill Highway, and also allows transportation to and from site, 28 2C:78-54 Page 2

thus addressing L.C.D.C. Goal No. 12, Transportation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

 The property affected by the proposed change of zone is adequate in size and shape to facilitate those uses normally allowed in conjunction with such zoning.

6 2. The property affected by the proposed change of
7 zone is properly related to streets and highways to adequately
8 serve the type of traffic generated by such uses that may be
9 permitted therein.

3. The proposed change of zone will have no adverse
effect or only limited adverse effect on any property or the
permitted uses thereof within the affected area.

4. That the proposed change of zone is in keeping
with any land use plans duly adopted and does, in effect, represent
the highest, best and most appropriate use of the land affected.

16 5. That the proposed change of zone is in keeping
17 with land uses and improvements, trends in land development,
18 density of land development, and prospective needs for development
19 in the affected area.
