FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

A hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon on February 14, 1979, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. dence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity and fits in with the neighborhood as is shown by the testimony presented at the hearing that this area of Klamath County is in need of day care facilities for children.
- The site has adequate access to streets and highways to carry the traffic flow generated by the proposed use, provided the conditions listed herein below are complied with.
- There would be no adverse affect on the abutting 3. property owners; although there was some testimony in opposition to the granting of this permit, those objections will be alleviated provided that the conditions listed herein below are complied with.
- The granting of this permit is consistent with the Goals of LCDC.
- This Conditional Use Permit is granted, contingent upon the Applicant's complying with each of the following conditions: 1. Applicant must meet all requirements of the Department of Environmental Quality. 2. Applicant must meet all requirements of the Klamath County Health Department.
- 3. Transportation of children to and from the property in question shall be provided by Applicant, so as to avoid the traffic flow which would be generated by each parent delivering and picking up their child or children. 4. The Applicant shall
