- 2. The granting of this Variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of the substantial property right of the Applicant, which is possessed by other property owners in the area, which is to have the full use of his property for residential purposes.
- 3. The granting of this request will not be materially detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare, and there has been no testimony in opposition to this Variance.
- 4. This Variance is the minimum Variance which will alleviate that exists.
- 5. The granting of this Variance is consisten with the Goals of the LCDC.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
