FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

A Hearing was held in this matter at Klamath Falls, Oregon, on February 14, 1979, pursuant to notice given in conformance with Ordinance No. 35, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The Applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Carl Shuck. The Hearings Reporter was Susan Baggett.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the Applicant. There were no adjacent property owners present who stated they had objections to the proposed Variance requested by the Applicant. John Kite, Chairman of the Keno Area Committee, was present and stated that the Keno Area Committee had no objections to the proposed Variance.

The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. There are exceptional and extraordinary circumstances which are applicable to this property which do not generally apply to other properties in the same vicinity, in that the 7.1 acres which is requested is presently separated from the other property by a roadway as well as a fence line.
- 2. A granting of this Variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right of the Applicant, which is possessed by other property owners in the area, which is the right to have full use of his property.
- The granting of the requested Variance will in no way be detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare.
- 4. The requested Variance is the minimum Variance is the minimum Variance which will alleviate the hardship.
- 5. The granting of the Variance is consistent with the Goals of LCDC.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
