ORDER

) Administrative Zone Correction

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the application of Louise Patterson for an Administrative Comprehensive Land Use Plan Change from Light Industrial to Agriculture and Zone Correction from SP-17 (Feed Lot) to AF (Agricultural-Forestry), by the Klamath County Planning Commission, on real property described as Township 41S, Range 8 EWM, Sections 4 and 5, Tax Lots 11,12,13 and 14. Public hearings having been heard by the Klamath County Planning Commission on October 24, 1978, where-13 from the testimony, reports and information produced at the 14 hearing by the applicant, members of the Planning Department Staff 15 and other persons in attendance, the Planning Commission found 16 that application for Administrative Change for Louise Patterson 17 18 should be granted. 19

The Planning Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as required by Ordinance No. 17, the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The Planning Commission found site for Administrative Change was approximately 457 acres in size, which meets the property development standards of the AF (Agricultural-Forestry) zone.
  - The Planning Commission found existing uses, such as 2.

 mobile homes, residences and shopebuildings on the approximately 457 acres to be in conformance with the proposed Agricultural-Forestry (AF) Zone.

- 3. Testimony from applicant indicated to Planning Commission that applicant had owned property since 1941 and that they always had land in agriculture uses, such as grain and or barley.
- 4. Testimony from applicant indicated that site for Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Correction had not been utilized as Light Industrial but as Agriculture, such as for raising of grain and alfalfa.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. The property affected by the Administrative Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Correction had existing uses prior to December 7, 1972.
- The property affected by the Administrative Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Correction was approximately 457 acres in size.
- 3. The property affected by the Administrative Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Correction represents the best and most appropriate use of the land.

NOW, THEREFORE it is hereby ordered that the application for the Administrative Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone Correction from Light Industrial to Agriculture and from SP-17 (Feed Lot) to AF (Agricultural-Forestry) for Louise Patterson on subject property is hereby granted.
