F5467 INSULATION COST REPAYMENT AGREEMENT AND MORTGAGE

(LIMITED WARRANTY)

This agreement is made this 30th day of November, 19 18 between Pacific Power & Light Company ("Pacific")

I. Homeowners represent that they are the owners or contract vendee of the property at:

hereinafter referred to as "the property."

2. Pacific shall cause insulation and weatherization materials to be installed in Homeowners' home as follows:

Insulate Office To an R38 Value (421.00) Weatherstrip 4 storm doors and caulk 12 windows (193.00)
Insulate Floor to an RIA (714.00) Less 100.00 Whap hot and cold water pies (112.00) Less 100.

The cost of the installation described above, for which Homeowners will ultimately be responsible under this agreement, is \$1340.00 Less 100.00

3. LIMITED WARRANTY PROVISION

3. LIMITED WARKAN I FROVISION

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation and weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above.

Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner. Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

H upon completion of ins allation. Homeowners believe the work is deficient. Homeowners must contact the Manager. Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company. EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES. ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEOWNERS. WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE HISTALLATION OF THE INSULATION. AND WILL TERMINATE OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES. NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary irom sute to state.

Pacific conducts Home Energy Analyses at the request of its custon eas to determine the cost-effectiveness of insulation and weatherization based upon average consumption patterns and typical local weather conditions. However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual casergy is in the santicipated benefits of insulation and weatherization, or by particular individual. Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of a oney or electrical consumption.

Pacific may petition the appropriate Oregon Legislature to amend current law to allow the Company, rather than individual owner-coupants, to receive the benefit of any tax credit accruing from the installation of energy saving materials provided for herein.

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property, except that in the case of a transfer due to death, such prior to the sale of the property is deemed to pass to any other person. Homeowners other than natural persons (corporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property, whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer, and not later than one week before the excepted sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to otherwise participating will be a sale or transfer, and not later than one week otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons so named and authorize and direct such persons to pay Pacific any obligations owing under this agreement from any monies which such persons owe to Homeowners.
